She is like a tree planted by the waterside, that yields her fruits in its time and flourishes even in the hardest times.

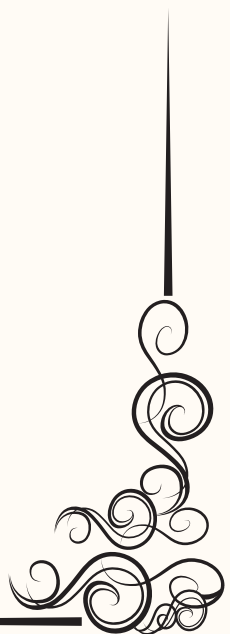
My mother is a friend in time of need and for all her services, she demands no reward.

She is prayerful, resourceful and kind. When she gives, its all from the heart.

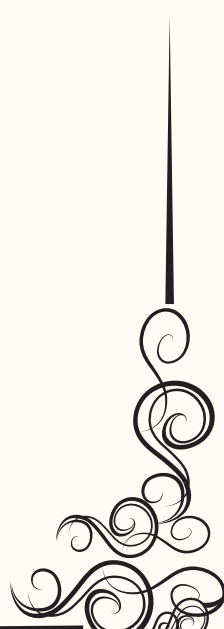
We salute our super mother who fathered us.

Mom, you always sacrificed to give us just what we needed to make us happy and happy we were indeed. We were sure of your love for us and that love kept us alive.

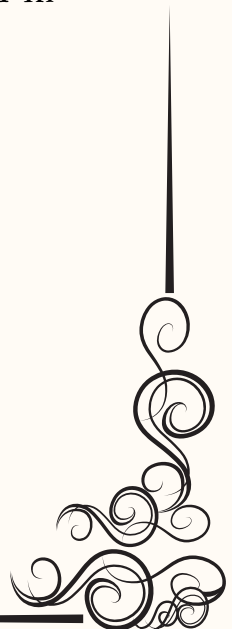
Mom could have chosen a different path, the road to please herself, instead she took the rough road and her kids have become her wealth. She traded her ashes for beauty and lifted her head up high.

every pain in you be healed.

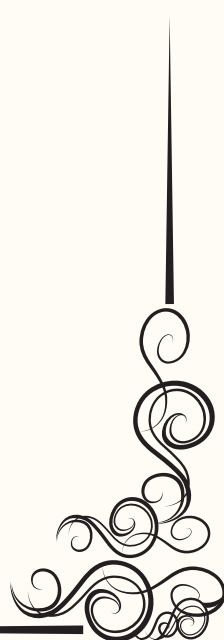

dwell in your heart forever.

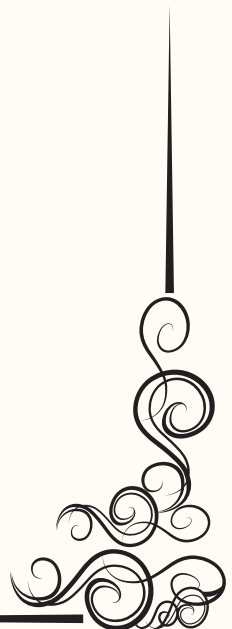
Mom, You have always been the wind that helped the boat of our

May each blessed day of your life brings the divine love and blessings of God. Happy birthday, Grandma. God's wiling, we have many more years to celebrate.



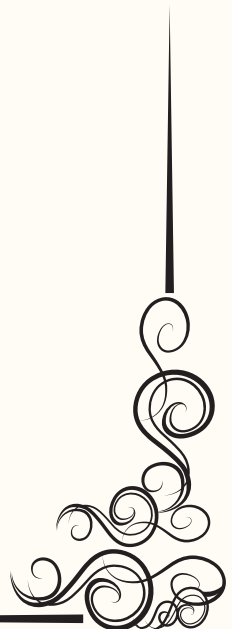

our every success and she is not afraid to reprimand us if she must.

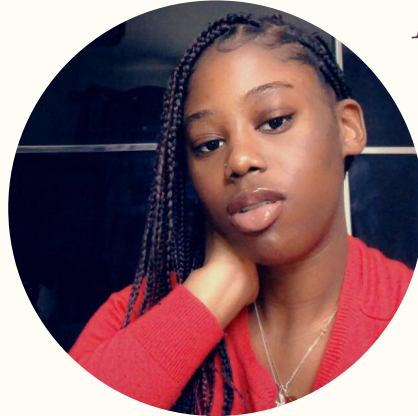

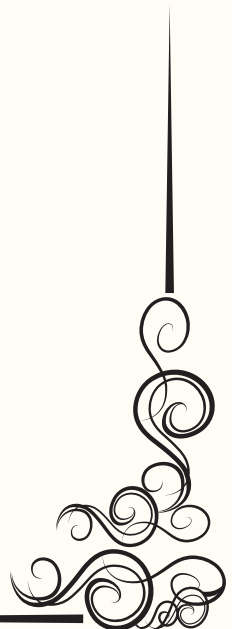
